

## **Detwilers “Drive Thru Service”**

The process is simple, straightforward, easy to use and there are no additional fees beyond the normal price of the grocery items offered. The process is as follows:

1. After 8:00 PM each evening, go to [Detwilermarket.com/drivethru](https://detwilermarket.com/drivethru). You will be directed to their site where you can download and print a 2-page PDF document. This is the order sheet for the 125+ of their most popular items that will be available the following day. The items include fresh produce, dairy, meats and seafood, deli, bakery and organic items.
2. Take your completed order sheet and drive to either of the two Detwiler stores offering the service: 1800 US 301, Palmetto, FL or 2881 Clark Rd. (at Swift Rd.), Sarasota. The hours for service are 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM, Monday through Saturday.
3. Follow the signs for Drive Thru service and stay in your vehicle. Once in line, a Detwiler associate will come to your car to take your order sheet. You remain in your car at all times.
4. A “runner” takes your order sheet and goes into the store to shop for your items. As this is being done, you remain in your vehicle as your waiting line advances to the pick-up area.
5. Once your order is complete, an associate brings your groceries to your car and loads them into your trunk. All items are bagged in paper. No reusable bags are permitted. As the groceries are being loaded, another Detwiler associate holds a card reader out for you. You insert your payment card into the reader and when ready, are asked to remove it. Apple Pay, EBT and NFC payments (contactless credit card) are accepted. This is an entirely “no touch” process. Note: cash, phone or email orders are NOT accepted.
6. You are on your way in 30 minutes or less from arrival to departure!

We have enjoyed the short drive to each of these stores and wanted to share this great service from one of the greater Sarasota community businesses. Although not available at the location on Lockwood Rd., the drive to the other stores has provided us with a nice respite from sheltering in place.
