FITNESS CENTER MAINTENANCE – If you have ever visited the Association's state-of-the-art Fitness Center, you would surely have noticed that the recumbent elliptical is one of the most popular exercise machines in the center. As such, it didn't come as a surprise when the Association learned it was the first machine to show some signs of wear and tear. A few weeks ago, Fitness Logic, the Association's Fitness Center maintenance company, advised that the machine's housing of the heart rate handles, which are designed to measure the pulse when one grasps them firmly during a workout, broke. Therefore, Fitness Logic had to temporarily glue the housing around the handles so users would still be able to use them and, at the same time, ordered new handles. And indeed, a couple of weeks ago, the new parts arrived and were immediately replaced. Thereafter, the recumbent elliptical was tested and was said to be in great working condition once again.
